Assignments:

This course is designated a Writing Course, thus all scheduled essays are part of the course requirements and must be submitted to pass the course. Completed essays must be submitted on the required dates at the beginning of class time. Any request for deferment for a medical or other important reason must be approved by the instructor before the due date and time.

Unauthorized late submission of essays will result in a mark penalty.

In the event of class cancellation due to weather or other extreme circumstance, essays will be due by 4.30 p.m. on the following day at the Resource Centre.

The essay must be no more than two 8½×11 in pages and must be typeset single-spaced 12 pt Times Roman font with 2.5 cm margins all round. Reference(s), using a recognized style, must be provided. The style (MLA, APA, etc.) must be noted. Back-to-back printing must be employed unless a special request is made. 1/3rd of the mark will be for writing skills and 2/3rd for content.
